

*Davallia pyxidata*

(Davalliaceae)

- Common name:** Haresfoot fern.
- Localities:** Gold Creek, Moggill State Forest.
- Growth form:** An attractive epiphytic fern with a long, scaly, branching rhizome.
- Foliage:** Fronds 3-pinnate and up to 1 m long, with long petioles.
- Flowers and fruit:** Nil.
- Habitat:** Grows on trees in subtropical and dry rainforest, and also in wet eucalypt forests.
- Propagation and Management:** May be propagated from lengths of rhizome or from spores germinated in a humid atmosphere. A hardy species, easy to grow on trees which do not shed their bark, in humid situations, or amongst other vegetation on rocky outcrops.
- General:** Not common in our district.
